ORDER OF THE BOARD

On this 16th day of March, 1968, came on to be heard before the Texas State Board of Podiatry Examiners, duly in session, a certain complaint filed with the Board on the 15 day of February, 1968, in which it was complained that T. A. Dennis, D.S.C., had violated the provisions of Article 4573, Revised Civil Statutes of Texas, 1925, as amended, and in particular had written prescriptions for amphetamine and barbiturate drugs for certain individuals, with knowledge that said prescriptions were not for legitimate purposes in his practice, such violations being grounds for the revocation of the license of T. A. Dennis, D.S.C., to practice podiatry in the State of Texas. The said T. A. Dennis, D.S.C., having been duly cited to appear and answer herein, and the said T. A. Dennis, D.S.C., having appeared by his legal counsel, Stanley I. Weinberg, Attorney at Law, Dallas, Texas, and the charges and complaint having been read, and a plea of not guilty having been entered in behalf of the said T. A. Dennis, D.S.C., and the evidence on said complaint and charges having been introduced and heard, and after consideration of the charges and evidence against him of the violation of Article 4573, Revised Civil Statutes of Texas, 1925, as amended, the Board is of the opinion that the charges in the complaint are true, and that said license should be cancelled, therefore:

IT IS ACCORDINGLY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED, that the license to practice podiatry within the State of Texas, heretofore.

held by T. A. Dennis, D.S.C., is hereby revoked and cancelled.
