AGREED BOARD ORDER

BE IT REMEMBERED that on 08/11/98, came on to be considered the allegations against Stephen Winarick D.P.M. By letter dated May 07, 1998, the Texas State Board of Podiatric Medical Examiners "Board" gave preliminary notice to Dr. Winarick of its intent to investigate complaints, concerns, or reports filed against him. Dr. Winarick was duly notified of the allegations against him. Dr. Winarick has cooperated with the Board.

This order is executed under the authority of the Podiatric Medical Practice Act of Texas, article 4573d, which allows contested cases to be resolved informally. Dr. Winarick agrees to waive his rights to a formal hearing on this matter upon the signing of this order.

Dr. Winarick agrees to the following order and agrees to the findings of fact, the conclusion of law and the order set out herein:

FINDING OF FACT

1. Dr. Winarick is licensed as a podiatric physician in the State of Texas by the Texas State Board of Podiatric Medical Examiners (License Number 0522) to practice podiatric medicine in the State of Texas and is therefore subject to the jurisdiction of the Texas State Board of Podiatric Medical Examiners and the Podiatric Medical Practice Act of Texas and associated rules of the Board.
2. A complaint was filed against Dr. Winarick and he was provided with an opportunity to respond to the complaint and to show compliance with the law.
3. Dr. Winarick, as a podiatrist licensed in the State of Texas, must comply with the provisions of the Texas Podiatric Medical Practice Act of Texas, the applicable rules and Board Orders.
4. After discussion of the matters outlined in this Order, and subsequent communications between Dr. Winarick and Board Staff, the Board and Dr. Winarick, in order to avoid the expense, delay and uncertainty of a hearing, have agreed to the entry of an Agreed Order, dispensing with the need for further action in this matter. By his signature on the Order, Dr. Winarick does hereby waive his right to a formal hearing before the State Office of Administrative Hearings, and judicial review of the Order.
5. Dr. Winarick, was negligent to his patient [REDACTED], in the treatment of her bunion.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Dr. Winarick is required to follow the provisions of the Podiatric Medical Practice Act, Tex. Civ. Stat. Ann., Art. 4567, et seq., and associated rules of the Board.
2. Art. 4573 (b) and Ch. 376, 22 Tex. Admin. Code provide for the disciplining of a licensee who violates this Board's statute and/or rules.
3. Dr. Winarick's negligence is a violation of the Texas Podiatry Practice Act, Tex. Civ. Rev. Stat. Ann., Art. 4570 (d)(5) and (16) and 4573 (b), and Section 375.2 (a) of Title 22 of the Texas Administrative Code.

ORDER


THEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, The Board orders and Dr. Winarick agrees to the following:


1. Dr. Winarick shall complete at least 15 CME hours on bunion surgery by September 1999. These hours shall be completed over and above the hours required by all licensees.
2. Failure to complete this agreement within this time will result in a \$2,500.00 (Two thousand five hundred dollar) fine.

This order does not prohibit the Texas State board of Podiatric Medical Examiners from exercising its regulatory functions.

I, Stephen Winarick D.P.M., have read and understand the foregoing Agreed Order. I understand that by signing, I waive certain rights to a formal hearing before the State Office of Administrative Hearings and judicial review of this order. I signed it voluntarily.

I understand this agreed order contains the entire agreement between the parties and there is no other agreement of any kind, verbal, written, or otherwise. THIS ORDER IS A PUBLIC RECORD.


